<p>This course covers Flight Planning, Performance & Loading, Aerodynamics & Aircraft Systems, Navigation, Meteorology, Human Factors and Air Law. Part One consists of Human Factors, Meteorology, Performance and Loading. Part Two consists of Aerodynamics and Aircraft Systems (AGK), Flight Planning, Navigation and Air Law. A pass in the theory exams is usually required prior to an airline interview and acceptance. The pass mark for each examination is 70%, except for the Air Law where the pass mark is 80%. This course includes mock exams in preparation for the CASA exams. Each subject is tested separately by CASA</p>
