<p>A pass in the theory exam is required prior to attempting a Commercial Pilot Licence flight test. The course covers Flight Rules & Air Law, Aircraft General Knowledge (or Aircraft Systems & Instrumentations), Aerodynamics, Operations, Performance & Planning, Human Performance & Limitations or (Human Factors), Meteorology and Navigation. This course includes mock exams in preparation for the CASA exams. Each subject is tested separately by CASA</p>
